- 2. Sewer Upgrades: Waiting to hear back from Kyle Shern with Bio-Gard Incorporated about implementing a new system.
- 3. Municipality/Building Codes & Enforcement: Board is still working on getting a lawyer.
- 4. Street Signs: Looking into options for new signs.
- **5.** Covid Relief Funding: The board met via phone conference with Cindy Hultz to discuss options for funding use. Currently, the board is tabling discussions about the building used by Lion's Club.
- 6. Sales Tax: The board is working toward implementing a sales tax that will benefit the city of Cairo by providing funds for much needed maintenance and improvements.
- 7. Ordinance to Pay Board Members: We are working on writing and passing an ordinance that will allow board members to be paid for meetings. The ordinance cannot take effect until the board member is voted back into office.

#### New Business:

**1. Tool Purchase:** The Village has been approached about buying tools at a good price. We are waiting for seller to submit documents with list of tools and prices.
